We encourage harm reduction & seek to break social stigmas by further politicizing the conversation around sobriety. When we strive to maintain our lives independent from the influence of the colonizer's poisons, we celebrate the sacredness of sobriety & honor our ancestors. Break the cycle for coming generations.
